MINNESOTA STATE

North Star Promise Scholarship

- » Available Fall 2024
- » Creates a tuition and fee-free pathway
- » Last dollar program
- » Estimate of 15,000-20,000 students in first year

Who Qualifies for the North Star Promise Scholarship?

- » Must be a Minnesota resident
- » Attend a Minnesota State college or university, University of Minnesota, or Tribal College
- » Adjusted gross income under \$80,000
- » Not be in default on a state or federal student loan
- » New students, returning students, transfer students
- » Be enrolled taking at least one credit
- » No age limit
- » Meet satisfactory academic progress standards
- » Have not earned a baccalaureate degree
- » Be enrolled in a program or course of study that applies to a degree, diploma, or certificate

North Star Promise Scholarship Program Operations

- » FAFSA or Minnesota Dream Act application
- » Schools assess student eligibility each term
- » Administered like the State of Minnesota Grant/Financial Aid program





Our promise to you:


- **FREE** tuition and fees for all Minnesota students with a family income under \$80,000 with the North Star Promise Scholarship (starting Fall of 2024)

- The LOWEST tuition in the state
- Wrap-around support for basic needs, including campus food pantries, help with transportation, housing and childcare assistance programs, and mental health resources





Unfortunately, tuition and fees alone won't make college possible for many Minneapolis College students who must make a choice between staying in school or feeding themselves or their families or paying their rent.

They will need additional support to persist and graduate with credentials that will provide a long-term family-sustaining wage.

Who does Minneapolis College serve?



- More than 70% of students identify as being members of Indigenous or communities of color, international, low income, or first generation
- 56% of our students identify as BIPOC

- Average age: 26
- 61% receive financial aid
- 1,000+ are student parents
- 300+ are veterans

Additional funding is needed

- A recent survey of students revealed that the major reason students stop-out of a program is due to juggling work (often 2 jobs) and school or managing personal and family obligations.
- Many Minneapolis College students have experienced food insecurity and homelessness, foster care, are low income, first-generation, parents themselves, or have newly immigrated to this country. These students require basic needs support to take advantage of the North Star Scholarship Program.

Scholarship funds help students succeed

- The Random Acts of Kindness Fund provides emergency assistance funding for students who are experiencing a financial crisis, so their education is not disrupted by a situation that is beyond their control.
- **General scholarships** are critical to supporting our students by providing funds for academic-related expenses. In addition to tuition and fees, scholarships provide for books, materials, tools, equipment, and transportation.
- Workforce Development Scholarships support students in high-demand fields: advanced manufacturing, agriculture, health care services, information technology, early childhood education and transportation—all industries struggling to meet talent and workforce needs.
