Jonathan Fox is a resident of Fowler, Colorado and has been affiliated with the Fowler State Bank for nearly 43 years. He has served as Chairman of the Board and CEO since 1992, also assuming the role as President of the bank in 2009. Jonathan graduated from the University of Colorado at Boulder with his Bachelor of Science degree in Finance and also holds a professional Real Estate Broker's License from the Colorado Division of Real Estate since 1980, serving as President and broker of The Fox Agency, Inc.

Mr. Fox is presently Chairman of the State of Colorado Banking Board appointed by the governor and approved by the Colorado Senate. He also serves the Fowler Chamber of Commerce, currently as Vice-President, President of the Cottonwood Links Golf Course and Ad Council President of the Fowler United Methodist Church. He is an assistant coach of the area 4H Livestock Judging Team as well.

He founded and serves as President, the Jonathan and Shari Fox Family Foundation, a 501(c)(3) which was begun for philanthropic purposes in 2004. He also serves on several other boards including the College of Music Advisory Board at the University of Colorado at Boulder, and formerly the Otero College Foundation Board, as well as several local scholarship boards of trustees. He conducts annually, Daniels Fund interviews for the Southeastern Colorado region as a part of that selection process, held at Otero College each Spring.
